SESSIONS

All sessions conducted entirely on artificial turf.

Elite Camp July 19-22

Elite-level field players and goalkeepers, ages 16-19. This session is for players who possess the athletic ability to develop their physical, mental and tactical skills to an elite level. Conducted entirely on turf (Jordan Field and Cumnock Fields). Enrollment is limited.

Tuition: \$425.

Open Camp July 26-29

Field players and goalkeepers, ages 12-16. All ability levels. This session will provide athletes with coaching on individual skills and techniques, along with tactics and game play. Goalkeepers will receive one-on-one instruction on the fundamental skills and techniques necessary to play this highly specialized position. Enrollment is limited.

Tuition: \$380.

Team Camp August 7-8

A two-day team camp. This session will include six high school teams. (Schools must each send a minimum of 16 players, including a goalkeeper, and not more than 20 players.) Instruction will be geared to team development in preparation for the upcoming season. Team Camp will be conducted entirely on turf (Jordan Field and Cumnock Fields).

Tuition: \$175 per athlete.
